

Driver Supervisor Job Description

Role and Responsibilities:

Responsible for dispatching driver assignments and coordinating client movements to passenger destinations through the efficient use and management of company equipment, fleet and drivers.

Essential Functions:

- Supervises, trains, develops, evaluates, and manages the performance facility driver associates
- Provides on-the-road training to ensure that all drivers are well-prepared to carry out their daily responsibilities in and effective manner
- Trains drivers on transportation standards, policies and procedures, and driving assignments
- Oversees vehicle specifications and preventive care programs for vehicles to ensure maximum safety while minimizing maintenance costs
- · Ensures drivers follow routes as assigned per company guidelines
- Works with drivers to develop and improve skills designed to allow them to assume increased future responsibilities • Ensures compliance with safety standards
- · Assists with hiring and disciplinary recommendations
- Acts as a point of contact for passengers, builds relationships, and addresses complaints
- Measures and reports service levels and fleet performance
 Leads continuous improvement in lean thinking and tools to eliminate waste
- Performs other duties as assigned
